AUCTION NOTICE FOR SPECIAL CLASS TIMBER

The Divisional Forest Office, Samdrup Jongkhar will be auctioning following timbers;

1. Teak (dead and dying), standing volume= **1,287cft.**
2. Teak (sawn) = **7.48cft.**
3. Teak (log) = **9cft.**
4. *Morus laevigata* (sawn) =**55.50 cft**, through auction on “**as is where is**” basis on **21.05.2024 at 3 PM** in the office of Chief Forestry Officer.

Therefore, all the interested bidders are requested to report to this office at 10 AM on the 21st May, 2024 for field inspection of timbers in collaboration with Forest Range Office, Samdrup Jongkhar.

The participants have to deposit the earnest money of **Nu 5,000 (Five thousand only)** before the auction in the form of demand draft or cash warrant in favor of Chief Forestry Officer. The earnest money will be returned for the unsuccessful bidders on the same day. However, the earnest money for successful bidder will be returned only after all timber are lifted with full payment.

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Terms and Conditions

1. Any Bhutanese national with valid CID shall be eligible to participate in the auction and deposit a non-refundable registration fee of Nu 1000.00 only at least one day prior to the noticed auction day.
2. The successful bidder shall deposit 50% of the total bid value on the day of the auction and the remaining 50% after completing the extraction of 75% of the allotted timber.
3. The successful bidder shall engage trained power chain operators, use protective gears and other safety measure.
4. The successful bidder shall be responsible for obtaining necessary permits via ofs.dofps.gov.bt and bear any applicable cost.
5. The successful bidder will be responsible for the maintenance of the farm roads/private roads/properties damaged due to extraction and transportation of timbers.
6. In the event of a successful bidder withdrawing the work before completion, the CFO shall forfeit the 50% bid value deposited and the site shall be put up for subsequent auction and the bidder will be barred from participating in the future auction.
7. The successful bidder shall extract the timber in logs form. However, depending on the accessibility, they may extract in the sawn form after seeking approval from CFO.
8. All bidders shall report to Divisional Forest Office, Samdrup Jongkhar at 10am on the day of auction to inspect the timbers at the site.
9. The successful bidder should complete the work within 30 days from the day of allotment. However, if the work cannot be completed within the allotment timeframe, the bidder should inform the CFO for further course of action.
10. The successful bidder will be liable for penalty as per the existing relevant Acts and Rules in place in case of breaching any of the above terms and conditions.
