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Terms and Conditions

1. Any Bhutanese national with valid logging license shall be eligible to participate in the auction and deposit a non-refundable registration fee of Nu 1000.00 only at least one day before the noticed auction day.
2. The successful bidder shall deposit 50% of the total bid value on the day of the auction and the remaining 50% after completing the extraction of 75% of the allotted timber.
3. The successful bidder shall engage trained power chain operators, and use protective gears and other safety measures.
4. The successful bidder shall be responsible for obtaining necessary permits via ofs.dofps.gov.bt and bear any applicable cost.
5. The successful bidder will be responsible for the maintenance of the farm roads/private roads/properties damaged due to the extraction and transportation of timbers.
6. In the event of a successful bidder withdrawing the work before completion, the CFO shall forfeit the 50% bid value deposited and the site shall be put up for subsequent auction and the bidder will be barred from participating in the future auction.
7. The successful bidder shall extract the timber in log form. However, depending on the accessibility, they may extract in the sawn form after seeking approval from the CFO.
8. All bidders shall report to the Divisional Forest Office, Samdrup Jongkhar at 10 am on the day of the auction to inspect the timbers at the site.
9. The successful bidder should complete the work within 15 days from the day of allotment. However, if the work cannot be completed within the allotment timeframe, the bidder should inform the CFO for further course of action.
10. The successful bidder will be liable for penalty as per the existing relevant Acts and Rules in place in case of breaching any of the above terms and conditions.
